# This Privacy Policy tells you how Calvert Exmoor uses any information that you give us

Calvert Exmoor is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide information by which you can be identified at any point (including but not limited to bookings and donations) you can be sure that it will only be used in accordance with this policy.

We may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this policy from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes.

#### 1) What we will do with the information we collect

We will never share, sell or rent your personal information to third parties (unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so). We may use your personal information to send you information about Calvert Exmoor news, fundraising, accessible breaks and activities, and how the public can help support people with disabilities at the centre, under GDPR regulations.

If you have previously agreed to us using your personal information you may change your mind at any time by emailing or phoning to update your preferences or unsubscribe.

You may request details of personal information which we hold about you under the Data Protection Act 2018. A small fee will be payable. If you would like a copy of the information held on you please contact us.

If you believe that any information we are holding on you is incorrect or incomplete, please contact us, we will promptly correct any information found to be incorrect.

We may use this information for internal record keeping, and to customise the website according to your interests. From time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone, or post.

#### 2) Legal Structure

This website is owned and copyrighted by Calvert Exmoor. The legal name and registered charity number of the organization is listed in the footer of every page on this website.

#### 3) Security

We are committed to making sure that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect.

#### 4) Links to other websites

Our website may contain links to other websites that we think you will find interesting. However, we do not have any control over any other websites that we have provided a link to, and therefore we can't be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst visiting such sites, and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement.



We also can't be held responsible for the content of external websites we link to, because we don't produce, maintain or update them, we can't change them, and they can be changed without our knowledge or agreement.

Some of our external links might be to websites which also offer commercial services, such as online purchases. The inclusion of a link to an external website should not be understood to be an endorsement of that website or the site's owners, services, or products.

#### 5) How we use cookies

Cookies are small text files that are stored by your browser on your computer or mobile phone. They allow websites to store such things as user preferences, allowing them to respond to you as an individual. Website can tailor their operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We use this information for statistical analysis purposes.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website by enabling us to monitor which pages our visitors find useful and which they do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you explicitly choose to share with us.

#### 5b) Third Party Cookies
